## **Pioneer Days - October 3 & 4, 2020**

### **Market Vendor Information and Application**

Vigo County Parks and Recreation Department is beginning to plan the 48<sup>th</sup> annual Pioneer Days, scheduled for October 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> at Fowler Park from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. You are invited to join us this year in the Market. The Market will be located south of the covered bridge. Each participant will receive a reminder letter and map of your location closer to the date. We encourage you to sell items that are homemade and/or handcrafted; however, other items will be permitted upon approval.

Spaces in the Market are approximately 30 feet wide and 20 feet deep. **No tents, tables or electricity are provided.** Cars, trucks, and/or trailers will only be permitted on the grounds for loading and unloading. Once unloaded, you must move your vehicles to the parking lot by the Beach on the opposite side of the lake. You can then walk through the Pioneer Village to return to your market space. Please make sure you have enough items to sell for the entire day. Parking at Shelter A (near Market) is reserved for Food Vendors. If you are disabled, please let us know and we will do our best to accommodate. **You will be issued two parking passes.** Additional vehicles will need to pay \$5 per day and park in the visitor lot on Bono Road.

The fee for each space is \$20 per day. No more than three spaces per vendor are allowed. \*NO REFUNDS will be issued. If you are selling/doing anything that might result in a patron getting sick and/or harmed, you should ensure that your personal insurance covers your liability.

**Completed application and payment must be submitted by Friday, August 21, 2020.**

***\*This year is not a typical year due to the current status of the COVID-19 pandemic. Due to the daily evolving status of the pandemic, please anticipate potential changes made to event protocols. The Vigo County Parks and Recreation Department is mandated by the state and the local health department to abide by and enforce all safety and social-distancing protocols in efforts to protect the health and well-being of park patrons, vendors and staff. If circumstances arise where we will have to cancel Pioneer Days, all event vendors that have already submitted vendor fee payment will receive a full refund. We ask all vendors to bear with us as we navigate this challenging time.***
