Annual Meeting

Our plan is to try to get back in the routine of holding an annual meeting for all members of the village. Ideally, we would like to hold it in January each year, but this year with Covid still being very prevalent, we are going to postpone this meeting until May. Having the meeting later in the year we are hoping that Covid numbers will be better and we will also have the option of having our meeting outside with more space to social distance. This year we will be combining the annual meeting with the VCPRD volunteer appreciation luncheon on Saturday May 1st. More information will be coming out later, so mark your calendar now.

Fire Safety

As part of the fire safety plan for the cabins, the VCPRD has purchased new ash buckets with lids and shovels for each cabin. At the end of each day of each event, fireplaces need to be cleaned out so that no hot coals are left in them. Coals should be shoveled into the ash bucket and place lid on tightly. Then buckets can be left in fireplace to cool overnight and dumped the next day /next event. Please put screen in front of fireplace to prevent any rouge sparks from escaping. The Fowler Village Folk will be purchasing heat resistant leather gloves for each cabin to help prevent burns. If you are unable to dump your ash bucket on your own, please let someone know. We ask that you never leave your fire unattended.
